## Introduction

This guide describes the Credit Detail and Student Credit and Marks Detail and includes how to use Interim Grades/Marks.

### **STU160.FMX      Credit Detail**

**Menu Path:** *Common View > Credit Details*

This form is a historical view of credits earned for a specified student (what the student has actually accomplished). This information follows the student throughout their academic career. It can be used to determine whether prerequisites have been met.

Credits (marks) for courses are updated at year-end transition or at the time a student is withdrawn. Information can be entered directly on this form (for new students from different districts) and that information is reflected immediately. The ability to make changes is a security issue determined by the district. The following information displays or does not display based on selections made in SYS001 Company Update:

- Failed courses
- Dropped courses
- Zero credit courses

When the Company File option “Move Interim Grades/Marks to Credit History” is checked, an “Interim Grades/Marks” button displays. See the Interim Grades/Marks Credit Details document to see how you have the ability to store interim grades in Credit History when a student drops a course, withdraws from school (home school and/or cross-enrolled school), or transitions to the next school year.

**NOTE:** Failed courses display in red.

## Interim Grades/Marks

This section explains how to use the Interim Grade/Marks Retained feature. The new screen STU161 Interim Grades/Marks Credit Details gives you the ability to store interim grades in Credit History when a student drops a course, withdraws from school (home school and/or cross-enrolled school), or transitions to the next school year. Interim grades/marks are stored in credit history for a student for reference and allows the counselor to view all the reported grades for a specific course.

### SYS001.FMX Company Update

**Menu Path:** *Administration > Company*

Select the Company file option “Move Interim Grades/Marks to Credit History” (COMPANY.RETAIN\_INTERIM\_GRADES). This indicates whether or not to retain interim grades when a course is moved to credit history (by dropping a course after the retention period, by withdrawing from school after the retention period, or by YET). When checked all associated interim grades from STUDENT\_MARKS are moved to CREDITS\_INTERIM\_GRADES.

## Procedures

### When a course is dropped

1. Select a student course selection on STU541 and select DROP.
2. If the course is moved to credits, the system checks the Company file “Move Interim Grades/Marks to Credit History”. If checked, the system moves all interim grades associated to the dropped course from STUDENT\_MARKS to CREDITS\_INTERIM\_GRADES.

### **When a student withdraws from school from STU170**

1. Withdraw a student from home school only or from home school and cross-enrolled school from STU170 (Withdrawal screen)
2. For each course selection if the course is moved to credits, the system checks the Company file “Move Interim Grades/Marks to Credit History”. If checked, the system moves all interim grades associated to the dropped course from STUDENT\_MARKS to CREDITS\_INTERIM\_GRADES.

### **When a student withdraws from school from STU185.**

1. Withdraw a student from a cross-enrolled school from STU185 (Cross-Enrollment screen) For each cross-enrollment course selection if the course is moved to credits, the system checks the Company file “Move Interim Grades/Marks to Credit History”. If checked, then system moves all interim grades associated to the dropped course from STUDENT\_MARKS to CREDITS\_INTERIM\_GRADES.

### **View interim grades for a student**

1. Navigate to Credit Details for a selected student (STU160/164). If the course is moved to credits, the system checks the Company file “Move Interim Grades/Marks to Credit History” and displays “Interim Grades/Marks” button.
2. Select “Interim Grades/Marks” button to access Interim Grades/Marks Credit Details (STU161).
  - If accessing STU161 Interim Grades/Marks Credit Details from the Credit List screen (STU160), the Student Query block populates with the selected student, and populates the Credit block with all credit records. The interim grades in the Interim Grades block displays for the selected credit record (in the Credit block).
  - If accessing STU161 Interim Grades/Marks Credit Details from the Credit Detail screen (STU164), the Student Query block populates with the selected student, and populates the Credit block with the selected credit record (from STU164). The interim grades in the Interim Grades block displays for the credit record in the Credit block.
3. The system populates the Interim Grades block with records stored in CREDITS\_INTERIM\_GRADES table associated to selected student and selected credit.

### Adding new interim grades for a student for a new credit

1. Add a new credit record in Credit Details for a selected student (STU160/164). System stores record in CREDITS.

**Note:** Required fields include:

- CREDITS\_INTERIM\_GRADES.REPORT\_CYCLE\_LONG\_NAME;
  - CREDITS\_INTERIM\_GRADES.REPORT\_CYCLE\_SHORT\_NAME;
  - CREDITS\_INTERIM\_GRADES.END\_DATE.
2. Select the "Interim Grades/Marks" button to access STU161 Interim Grades/Marks Credit Details.
  3. Add interim grade records for the selected student and credits.

**Important:** It is recommended that the user enter the Reporting Periods consistent with the format used by the school.

- For future purposes i.e. transcript, if you need to map these values (grades) to a reporting period, it needs to be consistent.
- If you want to map historical grades to the transcript in certain columns (pulled from the current reporting per naming conventions) they need to be kept consistent.

### Updating interim grades for a student for a credit

1. From STU160 Credit Detail or STU164 Student Credit/Credit Marks Detail, select the credit record for selected student and select the "Interim Grades/Marks" button. In STU161 Interim Grades/Marks Credit Details update interim grade records for the selected student and credit.
2. Save changes.

### **Deleting interim grades for a student for a credit**

1. From STU160 Credit Detail or STU164 Student Credit/Credit Marks Detail select the credit record for selected student and select the “Interim Grades/Marks” button. In STU161 Interim Grades/Marks Credit Details delete the interim grade record(s) for the selected student and credit.
2. Select SAVE. You will be asked “Are you sure you want to delete interim grade/mark record(s)?” Select OK.

### **Withdrawing student from original home school from STU169 (Seattle Home School Transfer).**

1. Navigate to STU169 Seattle Home School Transfer.
2. Select to withdraw a student from the “original” home school and make the original cross-enrolled school the student’s new home school.
3. For each original home school course selection, the system checks the Company file “Move Interim Grades/Marks to Credit History”. If checked, system moves all interim grades associated to the dropped course from STUDENT\_MARKS to system moves all interim grades associated to the dropped course from STUDENT\_MARKS to CREDITS\_INTERIM\_GRADES.

It also can be used to add new interim grades for a student for a new credit, update interim grades for a student for a credit and delete interim grades for a student for a credit.

**Note:** A Credit must exist before an Interim Grade/Mark can be entered.
